Errata

Page 10: The second bold paragraph should read, **“Below the question in Part A you will see a large answer box. This is called the Show All Work box. You will solve the problem and show your work in this box, using the math symbols on the right to help you show your work. Take some time now find the number keys on your keyboard and review the math symbols in the equation builder in the box to the right. Some questions have a large answer box and a small answer box. The math symbols in the equation builder can only be used in the large answer box. You may use your keyboard to enter any math operation in the small answer or equation box.”**

Page 25: In the first box, the third sentence of the last paragraph should read, **“You may also use scratch paper for planning or to draw out webs or outlines.”**

Page 25: In the last box, the first paragraph should read, **“The Prewriting/Planning tab is not intended to be a space to write your full response, but you can move anything you have typed in the planning tab to the Final Draft response box on the right side of the screen. To move text, you can copy and paste. Be sure not to delete or cut text when you copy and paste. The following directions explain what to do if you accidentally delete text. Let’s practice doing this together.”**

Pg. 26: The second paragraph under *For PCs or Chromebooks* should read **“Next, use keyboard commands to copy or paste. To copy, press Control and c. To paste, press Control and v. Do not press any keys before you paste, or you may delete the text you copied. If you need to undo an action, such as copying the wrong information or deleting text, press Control and z. You can use undo as many times as necessary.”**

Pg. 26: The second paragraph under *For Macintosh computers* should read **“Next, use keyboard commands to copy or paste. To copy, press Command and c. To paste, press Command and v. Do not press any keys before you paste, or you may delete the text you copied. If you need to undo an action, such as copying the wrong information or deleting text, press Command and z. You can use undo as many times as necessary.”**

Pg. 26: The third paragraphs under *For iPads* should read **“To paste the text you have copied, tap and hold your finger on a location in the Final Draft response box. After you release your finger, a menu will pop up above the text. The option to paste is in this menu. Select ‘Paste.’ Do not select any other text or type anything before your paste, or you may delete the text you copied. If you need to undo an action, such as copying the wrong information or deleting text, bring up the touchscreen keyboard and choose ‘.?!23.’ Select ‘undo.’ You can use undo as many times as necessary.”**

Page 58: The first paragraph in the SAY box should read **“Read the problem silently and find the correct answers to Part A and Part B of Question 5. In Part B there is an answer box. Some answer boxes do not allow certain characters. For example, some answer boxes do not allow letters. If you receive an Invalid Input error when typing in the answer box, you have entered a character that is not allowed. When you are finished answering Part A and Part B, stop and we will discuss the question together.”**

Page 82: In the second SAY box, the second paragraph should read **“Read Question 4 and enter your answer in the answer box. Some answer boxes do not allow certain characters. For example, some**

answer boxes do not allow letters. If you receive an Invalid Input error when typing in the answer box, you have entered a character that is not allowed. When you are finished, stop and we will discuss the question together.
